4. Answer the following questions (30–35 words)

(i) What trees does Mr Wonka mention?

Answer:

Mr Wonka mentions many trees such as the **Douglas fir, oak, cedar, elm, larch, and pine**. He says these trees are strong, useful, and have an important place in nature and human life.

(ii) What are the games or human activities which use trees, or in which trees also ‘participate’?

Answer:

Trees participate in many human activities. They are used in **cricket** (bat and stumps), **tennis** (rackets), **table tennis, baseball**, and in making **boats, houses, furniture, and paper**.

5. Answer the following question (40–50 words)

(i) Why does Maya think Mr Nath is a crook?
Who does she say the Sunday visitor is?

Answer:

Maya thinks Mr Nath is a crook because he lives alone, has no friends, rarely goes out, and receives only one visitor every Sunday. She believes the Sunday visitor is **his partner in crime**, who brings him money and discusses secret plans.

What was the author's opinion about Mr Gessler as a bootmaker?

Answer:

The author believed that **Mr Gessler was an excellent and devoted bootmaker**. He made boots with great skill, care, and honesty using the finest leather. His boots were durable and comfortable, but he suffered because he did not advertise like big companies.
